Next May, the competition will be hosted by the UK and Ireland at Trinity College Dublin.

The competition consists of a series of physics problems, covering a wide variety of topics in physics and requiring varying degrees of previous knowledge. On top of the competition, during the three days different social and scientific activities are held. Among these are lectures, workshops, poster sessions and tours. In the past, PLANCKS has been honoured by the attendance of several Nobel laureates including: Wolfgang Ketterle, Didier Queloz and Reinhard Genzel. The first PLANCKS in 2014 hosted Stephen Hawking and since then we have had many other prominent keynote speakers including Dame Jocelyn Bell Burnell and Jim Al-Khalili.

The purpose of PLANCKS is to strengthen the international ties between students and to stimulate the individual student's personal growth. It is the ideal environment to share your love of physics, passion for problem-solving and actively engage in discussions that transcend borders.

Over the past seven years, PLANCKS has grown substantially in the UK and Ireland, from a contest of three teams and a dozen participants to a colossal event that brings together like-minded individuals to share their love for physics and problem-solving. We expect **200 participants** and **50 observers** from nearly **40 countries** to take part in an exciting programme of social, cultural, and educational events.

In addition to the main competition, the event will also consist of interesting talks and fun social events. To book the best speakers for PLANCKS Dublin 2024, we are collaborating with IOP Ireland and the IOP London & South-East Branch, which regularly organises talks, where the speakers are some of the world's leading scientists.
